

hablarenarte: and FelipaManuela are launching "Sweet Home," a research residencies program in Madrid for international artists and cultural agents.

We are seeking for artists, curators, managers or other cultural agents, who do not live or work in Spain, wanting to research in Madrid. Each residency will have a duration of two weeks, between September and December 2013, in one of the six private homes of the cultural agents selected in a previous local call.

Each host will provide accommodation for the guest, and will introduce the international cultural agent in his/her closest artistic context. The program covers the cost of accommodation. The resident guest should assume his/her travel and subsistence expenses during these two weeks.

This call is adjusted according to the following:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Target: Cultural agent non-resident in Spain, of any branch related to the culture and contemporary art.

2. Calendar: We offer six two-week residences within the period between September 1 and December 31, 2013.

3. Application: Besides the Applicant Profile, the attached form must specify the artistic research project to develop by the resident in Madrid that justifies his/her stay.

4. Commitments of the host: This is a teambuilding residence. Both host and guest must respect and promote the overall harmony of the home. The host has NOT commitments of any kind regarding to the cleaning, meals, use of common rooms, etc.., beyond the proper disposal of the house for the comfortable accomodation of the guest. To promote coexistence and sharing personal and professional experiences, the local cultural agent undertakes to introduce the resident into his/her closest artistic context.

5. Commitments of the guest: The artist or cultural agent must maintain the residence spaces in good condition of use. At the end of residence, he or she undertakes to perform a surface cleaning, tidy up the room and return the key of the house to the host before he or she finally leaves the house.

The resident agrees as well to develop and implement the research project he was selected for to reside in Madrid.



6. Commitments of the organization: hablarenarte: association and FelipaManuela undertake to set an agenda of activities that will help the resident to develop his/her research, and further enhance the resident to work with local agents as well. The organization will also mediate between resident and host and promote the good relationship among them.

7. Liability: hablarenarte: and FelipaManuela are not house owners, and they do not sell, give, provide, rent, manage and / or control any properties. hablarenarte: and FelipaManuela are not responsible for any loss of property as well as personal or material damage that may occur during, or because of the resident's stay, or that could be sensed as originated by these residences.

8. Application dates, selection criteria and resolution: the application form [Word format] can be downloaded from the website **www.hablarenarte.com**. There is no age limit and participation is free. Application dates: from May 27 to June 28, 2013. Application deadline: June 28, 2013.

hablarenarte: and FelipaManuela, together with the six local hosts selected in the first open call, will choose the international cultural agents considering their profile and research project. The selection results will be announced before July 19, 2013.
